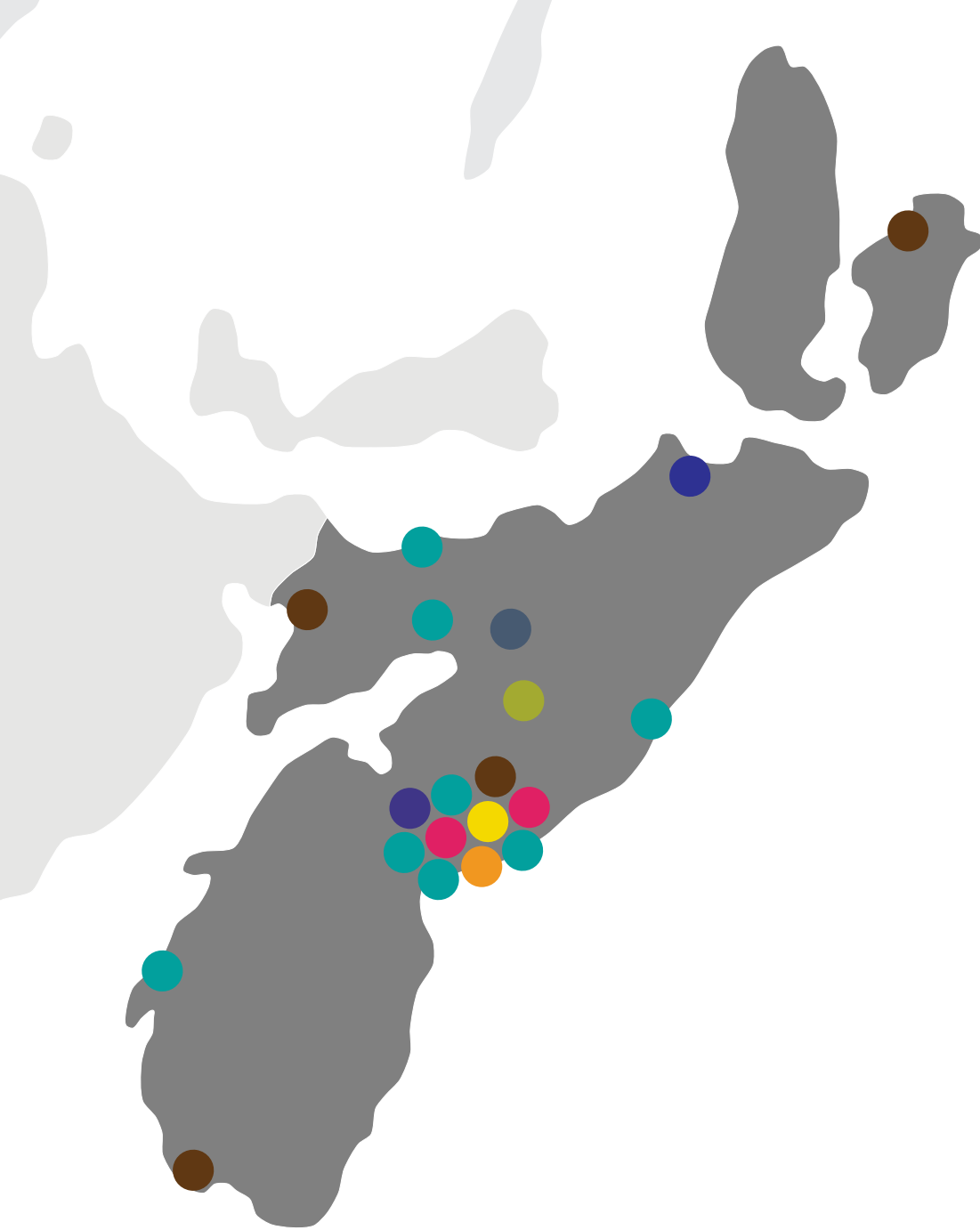
Government Patient Safety Network

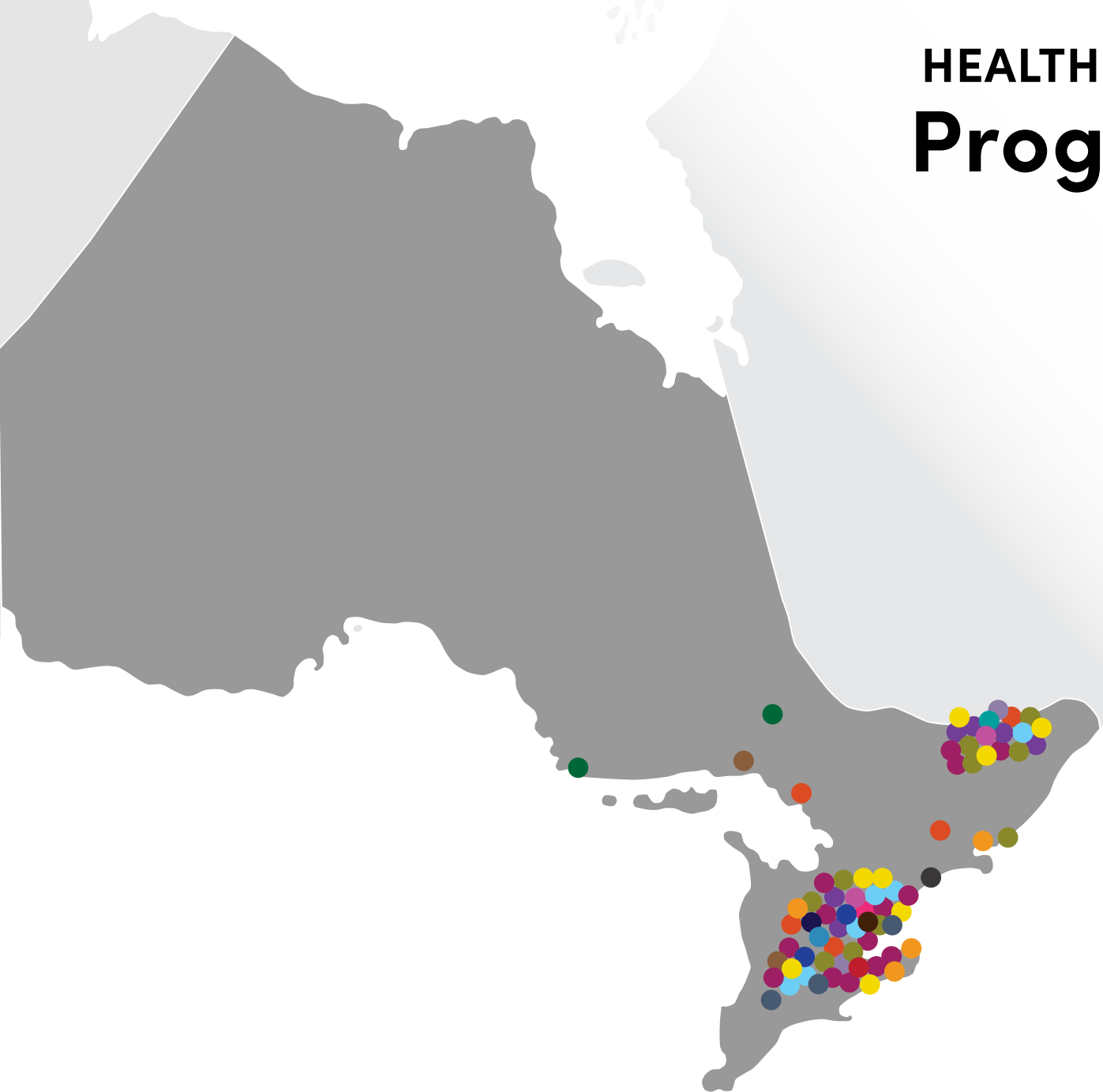


